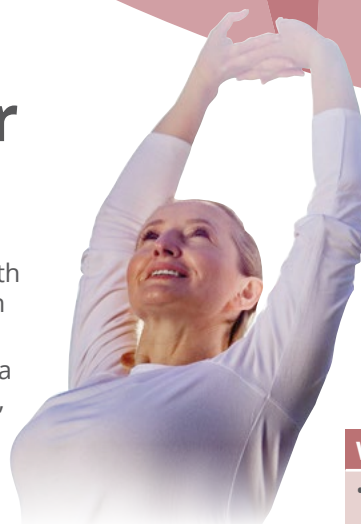

Spotlight on breast reconstruction

My Hyder Ridha, Consultant Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgeon

It is estimated that around a quarter of the women diagnosed with breast cancer each year in England undergo a mastectomy. Of those, around one third opt to have breast reconstruction, with a significant proportion choosing delayed reconstruction, after they are better recovered from their surgery and treatment. (source: Breast Cancer Now)

What is breast reconstruction?

Breast reconstruction is surgery that restores the shape and volume of a breast following its complete or partial removal during the treatment of breast cancer. Any woman who is about to undergo or has had surgery for the treatment of breast cancer should have the opportunity to discuss her breast reconstructive options if she wishes. Breast reconstruction can be performed at the time of the mastectomy or later depending on the patient's preference and whether any further treatment is required, such as chemotherapy and/or radiotherapy.

What does the surgery involve?

There are many different types of breast reconstruction available, most commonly implant based or using the

patient's own tissue. The complexity varies from simple procedures such as fat transfer to more complex microsurgical procedures. The type selected will depend on the patient's needs and will consider; the need to reconstruct part or a complete breast; the size of the original breast that the reconstruction needs to match; any planned further breast cancer treatment; and the general health of the patient.

“*Having been diagnosed with breast cancer and needing a double mastectomy, my consultant recommended that I meet with Mr Ridha and discuss the various options.*

About 25 years ago my mother also had breast cancer and a single mastectomy without reconstruction. I remember her showing me her scar and knew that I didn't want to look the same.

My surgery was mid-summer and the day after I was discharged from hospital after a double mastectomy and reconstruction I sat outside in my favourite sundress with my

How long is the recovery time and what results can be expected?

This depends on the type of reconstruction and can vary from a day case procedure and a week of recovery to a procedure that requires a hospital stay and a six week recovery. Breast reconstruction aims to restore the shape and volume of the breast. This can go a long way to help restore confidence and is an integral part of the road to recovery.

husband and children enjoying the sun and thinking just how fortunate I was.

Looking at me, nobody would ever have known what surgery I had undergone the week before. Breast cancer is a battle that I am still fighting but I can fight that whilst still looking like me. Obviously without the hair which chemo has almost taken but that is just hair and will grow back! I was very concerned about what I would look like post-surgery but in hindsight I can honestly say I shouldn't have been so worried.”

Mr Aza Mohammed, Consultant Urological Surgeon

An enlarged prostate is a very common condition

and, while not usually serious, can affect quality of life. We asked Mr Aza Mohammed to talk to us about available treatment.

What is an enlarged prostate?

An enlarged prostate is a very common condition for men as they start to age. 40% of men in their 50s and over 70% of men in their 60s have an enlarged prostate. As the prostate enlarges, it presses on the urethra, causing bothersome urinary symptoms such as:

- Frequent need to urinate both day and night
- Weak or slow urinary stream
- A sense that you cannot fully empty your bladder
- Difficulty or delay in starting urination
- Urgent feeling of needing to urinate
- A urinary stream which stops and starts

What treatment is available?

The UroLift® System is a minimally invasive procedure to treat an enlarged prostate that lifts and holds the enlarged prostate tissue so it no longer blocks the urethra. It is the only treatment for an enlarged prostate that does not require any cutting, heating or removal of the prostate tissue. The procedure is very quick and patients will generally only need to stay in hospital for a couple of hours after the procedure.

What about afterwards?

Patients typically return home the same day, without a catheter, and will see rapid relief in symptoms and a significant improvement in quality of life.

Are there any side effects?

Most common side effects are mild to moderate and resolve within two to four weeks after the procedure. They include pain or burning with urination, blood in the urine, pelvic pain, urgent need to urinate and/or inability to control the urge.

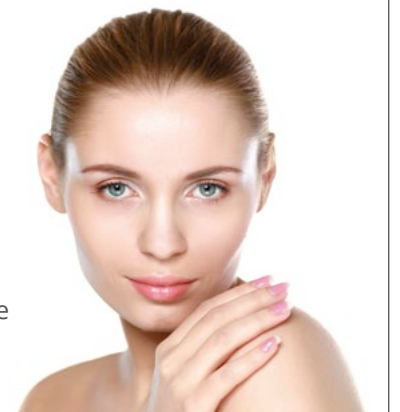

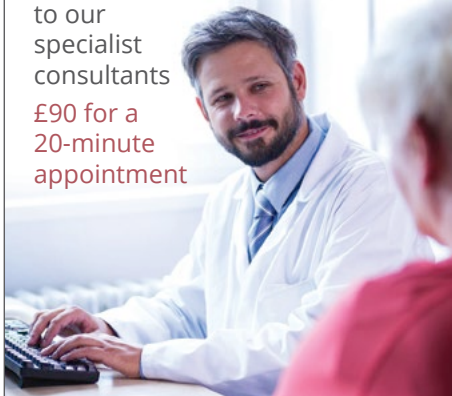
