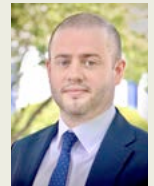

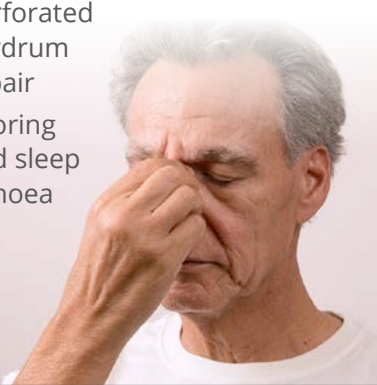

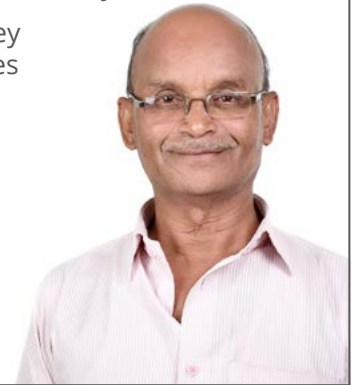
Minimally invasive surgical techniques mean surgery can often be carried out as a day case.

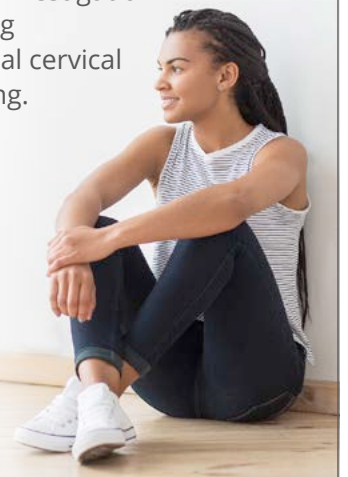

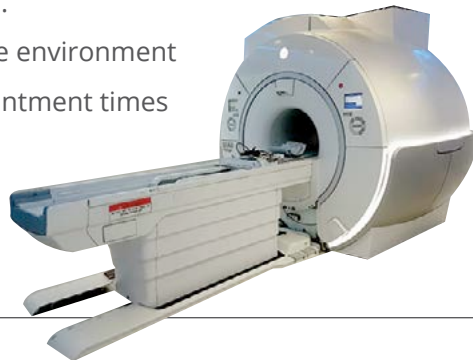
