Self-pay patient referrals

Patients do not have to be insured to be treated at One Hatfield Hospital and often fund their own treatment if time is of the essence, they do not meet the criteria for NHS treatment, or they want to choose which consultant they see.

We offer competitive and transparent fixed-price packages so our patients are assured they will not be surprised by additional bills. If self-pay patients would like to spread the cost of their treatment we offer 0% interest on monthly payments across 12 months, and low interest finance on loans between 12 and 60 months. (Terms and conditions apply. Subject to availability. Subject to status.)

Patients paying for their own treatment can choose to self-refer to One Hatfield Hospital by calling our Self-Pay Lead to book an appointment with one of our consultants. The cost of the consultation will be given at the time of booking and patients requiring further treatment will receive a quote for their procedure. A GP referral letter may be required to ensure the correct pathway of care is undertaken, and patients will be referred back to their GP at the end of their care pathway.

Insured patient referrals

We accept all major insurers and patients can use their insurance for the majority of services and treatments we offer.

The process is very easy. Patients should contact their provider to check their policy covers them and they will be given an authorisation code which will need to be provided for each appointment. Patients can tell their insurance provider they would like to be seen at One Hatfield Hospital and can call us directly to book their initial consultation. Diagnostics and treatment will be arranged if required. A GP referral letter is often needed to ensure the correct pathway of care is undertaken, and patients will be referred back to their GP at the end of their care pathway
