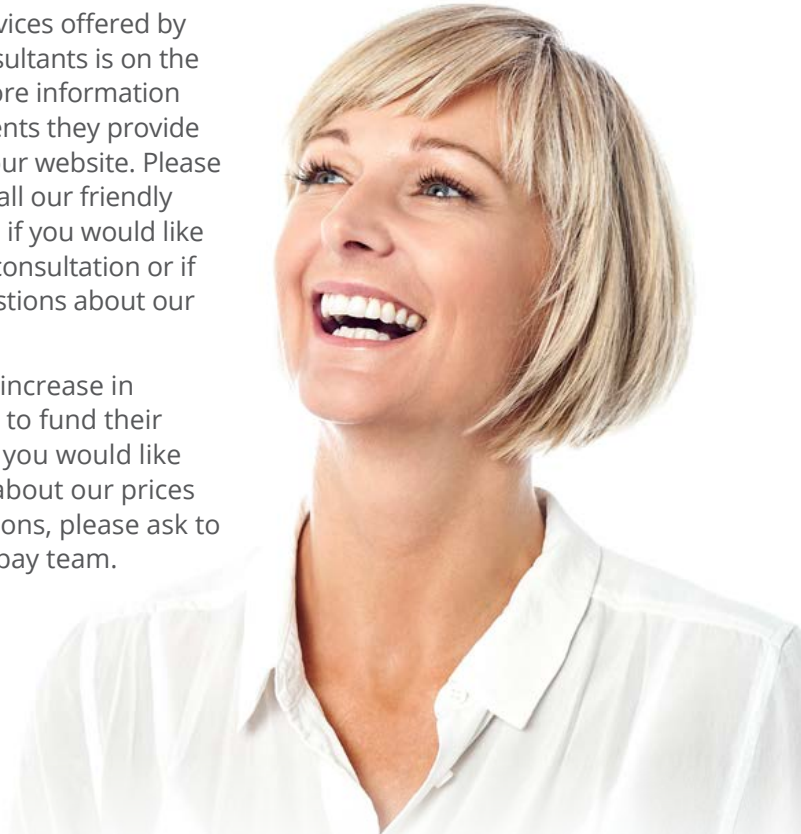

Do you suffer from shoulder pain?

Shoulder pain is extremely common, which isn't surprising given the complexity of the shoulder joint. It is a 'ball and socket' joint but unlike the hip where the ball is firmly positioned within the socket, the shoulder socket is very shallow. This is beneficial to us as it means we have great range of movement in the shoulder, but the strength and the stability of the joint comes from the muscles and ligaments that surround it. This means there are many problems that can occur and cause pain which can often be debilitating.

It can be tricky to understand what is causing your pain as there are several shoulder conditions with overlapping symptoms. One of the most common is called **impingement syndrome**, where pain is localised around the tip of the shoulder but can originate from the rotator cuff – a group of muscles that stabilise the shoulder joint. Other conditions include **frozen shoulder**, where

a painful stiffness develops, and **arthritis** of the shoulder where pain typically develops gradually over several years.

A specialist consultant will get to the cause of the problem. As well as a physical assessment they will ask questions about what has been happening so they can build a full picture. Scans such as an X-ray or MRI will confirm a diagnosis and determine your individual treatment plan.

Treatment will always start with conservative measures such as lifestyle changes, simple pain medication and physiotherapy. If no improvement is seen then injections may be recommended or, in some cases, surgery.

If surgery is necessary, many interventions can be performed using the most advanced minimally invasive techniques and patients can achieve permanent relief of symptoms and, most importantly, restore normal function.

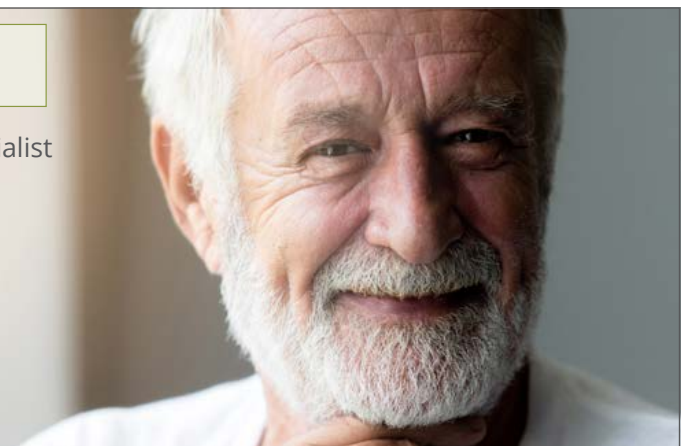
