Self-pay Referrals

There are times when you may want to discuss self-pay options with your patients, particularly if they wish to be seen as soon as possible.

Patients paying for their own treatment can choose to self-refer to One Ashford Hospital by calling our Reservations department to book an appointment with one of our consultants. The cost of the consultation will be given at the time of booking and patients requiring further treatment will receive a quote for their procedure. Please note that a GP referral letter may be required to ensure the correct pathway of care.

Insured Referrals

We are recognised by all major insurance companies and patients can use their insurance for the majority of services and treatments we offer – the process is very easy.

Patients should contact their provider to check their policy covers them and they will be given an authorisation code which will need to be provided for each appointment. Patients can tell their insurance provider they would like to be seen at One Ashford Hospital and can call us directly to book their consultation.

Diagnostics and treatment will be arranged if required. A GP referral letter is often needed to ensure the correct pathway of care is undertaken and patients will be referred back to their GP at the end of their care pathway.


